Code of Conduct/Release Form

Please read and sign the below form for your child if under 16, over 16's must read and sign themselves.

This is just a few ground rules to make sure everyone has a great time with the lessons and to ensure that you are all skating safe when learning.

1. Skateboarding is a dangerous activity, risk of injury is reduced when you wear the correct protective gear (pads and helmets) to take part you must be wearing the proper equipment that is correctly sized for you.
2. The guys giving you instruction must be listened to at all times during the lessons, they have a lesson plan and have been skating for many years between them. Please give them some respect and be attentive to what they have to say.
3. If you do not have any equipment then Ride With Us (Bored Skate Shack) will provide you with free rental of any items you may need (we have boards, pads and helmets) Please treat these loan items as you would treat your own kit and look after it, if items are misused or taken out of the skate park we may decide to discontinue your lessons.
4. There will be some guys there with cameras, both our photographers are CRB background checked and the images can be viewed at anytime.
5. Whilst lessons take place please remember to be polite and friendly to other participants, threatening or bullying behaviour is not tolerated, we operate a zero tolerance policy and you will be asked to leave.
6. Ride With Us (Bored Skate Shack) and Frome Town Council should like to make it clear that as stated before as with any activity skateboarding is dangerous, whilst pads and helmets are to be worn at all times during instruction neither party will be held responsible should any accident or injury occur.
